Home Industries Schedule

- All entries to be on official entry form (see back of schedule).
- All entries to be grown, made or created by the <u>named</u> exhibitor.
- Presentation of awards will be at **2.15pm on Show Day**.
- Entries, Cups, Trophies and Awards must remain in the hall until **3.30pm** of the Show Day.
- Judging will take place prior to show day.
- Judge's decision is final, & no correspondence will be entered into.
- A maximum of 1 entry by one individual exhibitor per category except where otherwise stated.
